



Infants - Water - Summer Term 2024



Maths

Y3 will start a new unit on Money and complete the Fractions unit. Y2 will look at Shape and Time

PSHE / RE.

We will be looking at our bodies and how we can keep them safe. We will also look at different religions. As well as understanding what it is to be still.

Our final topic this year is WATER. Through our learning we will discover more about God and his amazing creation and promises.
Our main focus this term is to understand God is our refuge - Psalm 46 ...there is a river ...be still ...comfort and gladness

Science

In science we are going to look at the properties of water, and to understand how substances can change state. Children will understand how water can change; solid, liquid and gas by evaporation, condensation, melting and freezing. We will also learn about the water cycle - *get ready for a song to never leave your brain!*
We will also be looking at how we can use water to produce electricity.

Topic

This term the children will be looking at the seaside. We take a look the history of the seaside as well as the geographical areas of seashores in the UK. We will also be investigating facts about the ocean and using our imaginations when we go 'under the sea'. We will also be looking at some stories of the Bible that are about water including: Moses parting the sea, Jesus walking on water and understanding Psalm 46.

English

During Guided reading this half term Y3 will look at a variety of comprehension texts and Y2 will read the book 'The book with no pictures' by B.J Novak. Next half term we will read poetry together.
In English we will be looking at the story of Jonah and the whale. We will be learning how to write diary entries, letters and postcards, newspaper articles as well as informative texts. We will also look at the Snail and the Whale book which will help the children to write poetically.

Music

Mr Martin will continue to teach recorders on a Tuesday. We will also be learning songs for the Spring Fair.

Art

Mrs Charles will be looking at movements in water, along with Monet's work. Psalm 46 will be used to look at rivers. The topic story of the parting of the sea will be linked as we look at what creatures would be revealed. We will also make a diorama to make a sea scape.

French

Mr Ford will continue to take Y3 for French on a Thursday.
