



Year 2 & 3 Summer Term



People Topic

Art

Children will be learning how to draw facial features to enable them to create a self-portrait and portraits in the style of a famous artist, e.g. Picasso.

English

This term we are introducing the topic of diversity and gaining an understanding of prejudice and discrimination. We are creating our own picture book as we look at various aspects of this topic.

On a Friday morning we will be doing diary writing.

Topic

We will start with thinking about who God says we are, research our own family history then consider why some people are famous. We'll look at Samuel Pepys & the Great Fire of London and the Queen's Jubilee. The 2nd half term we will look at the history of nursing including Florence Nightingale and Mary Seacole.

Science

We will be looking at the human body. We will begin with the skeleton and then go on to learn about our organs, human variation and growth and development.

In the 2nd half term, we will learn about how our muscles work and how to keep our bodies healthy through exercise and diet choices/ nutrition.

RE

In the first half term we are learning about the key features of different religious buildings.

In the 2nd half term, we will be looking at the leaders of different religious faiths.

PE

This term we are playing rounders and touch rugby

PSHE

1st half-term we are considering our bodies and the choices we can make – how to make safe choices and what to do if we have a concern. 2nd half-term we are looking at team work – how to have successful team work and what to do if conflicts occurs.

On a Thursday we will be working on time in the 1st half-term and money in the second half.
