

Bethany School Parent Survey - January 2026

As a school we want to hear the views of parents. To this end we conduct a survey of all our parents every two years. All parents on the school mailing list are sent the survey link and this year **fifty four parents** took part in the survey. The full results have also been shared with the Governors and staff team. The questions and standard responses for this year's survey have been revised in line with the Ofsted Parents View update (November 2025). Here is a summary of the survey's findings with our response. Where possible we have compared previous survey data with this year's data.

School response	Recent School Improvement Plan targets have been to ensure that individual targets for SEND pupils are accurately matched with needs, and to check progress against these regularly. Our current SEND target is a thorough review of inclusion across the school. We have made significant changes to our SEND provision in order to achieve our goals including increasing the hours of our SENDCO this year. It is encouraging to see an increase in parent satisfaction, with 67% of parents strongly in agreement with the support we are providing.
