



# Infant Class - Spring 2026 (Communication)



## Science

We will start by looking at how amazing our bodies work. We will then move onto looking at how technology has changed to help us communicate.

## Maths

For the first half of the term we will focus on shape, length and height. During the second half we look at fractions, money and mass.

## Music

Sheffield Music Hub will be teaching recorders and Mrs Baynes will teach us exciting notation, music history and composition in class.

## RE

During the first half term we will be looking at the Lord's prayer and look at how books of the Bible are categorised (and learn the order they come in). In the second half term we will look at how Jesus communicated with people and how how people communicated their feelings.

## Art

In the first half term we will be looking at Cuneiform tablets and creating our own. We will be looking at how paper is made and working together collaboratively to make recycled paper. We will link our maths knowledge to recognise patterns and symmetry and to know about the positives and negatives of printing.

## Hebrews 1 vs 1

In the past God spoke to our ancestors through the prophets at many times and in various ways, but in these last days he has spoken to us by his Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom also he made the universe.

## English

This term we will look at different ways in which we communicate, including; writing letters, emails, mime, drama. On a Wednesday, we will have a no pen/pencil day so we can only communicate through using our voices or with physical things around us. In drama we will look at the Tower of Babel and Elijah and the gentle whisper from God. Guided reading - we will be concentrating on retrieval of information from Bible stories and other short stories.

## PE

Mrs Knight will continue to take PE - please make sure children have warm clothes this term.

## Topic

This term we will be discussing the ways in which God communicates with us and how we can communicate with Him. We will also look at nature and how animals communicate with people and with each other. God communicates in many ways, often in quiet, unexpected moments, requiring us to actively stop, read the Bible, be still, and listen. We will look at the Anglo Saxons and see how life and communication has changed in history through inventions and technology. We will be asking how grandparents communicated when they were younger. Potentially visit some elderly people to find out about communication in their day.

## French

The Y3 will continue to have French on Thursday mornings with Mr Ford.

## PSHE

This term we will be looking at what it means to be a good citizen. We will look at the 10 commandments and discuss how important it is to have rules to keep us safe.. We will look at British Values, Democracy and what it means to keep the law. We will also discuss how we can get along with people who have different views to ours. In the second half of the term we will look at who makes up our community and how we can celebrate differences.

## Computing

We will continue to practice typing skills to enable all children to be able to log in to purple mash and google drive. We will design a presentation on google slides to show what they have learned from the internet safety which we have discussed in PSHE and computing lessons. They will also start to look at simple programming on purple mash.
